Sangma graduated from the Wharton School of Business and Imperial College, University of London. At the age of 30, he contested election for Meghalaya Assembly and became the youngest finance minister of the State. He was also elected Member of Parliament 2016-2018. To ensure accelerated growth and development of Meghalaya, he formulated a structured policy of governance with emphasis on education, health, sports, and environment, including his recent initiative to introduce Water Policy.
